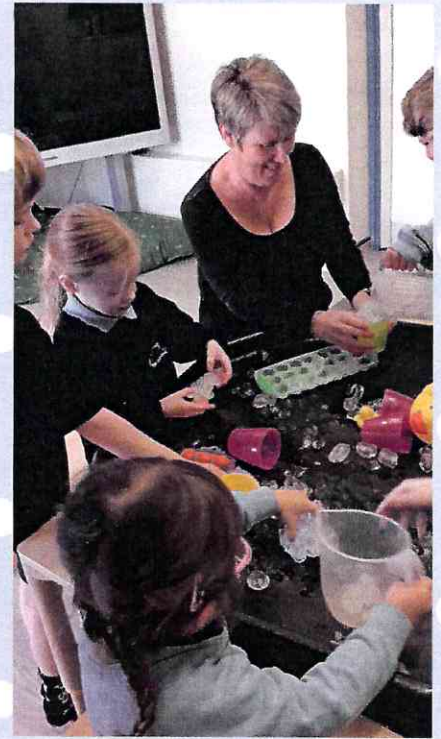

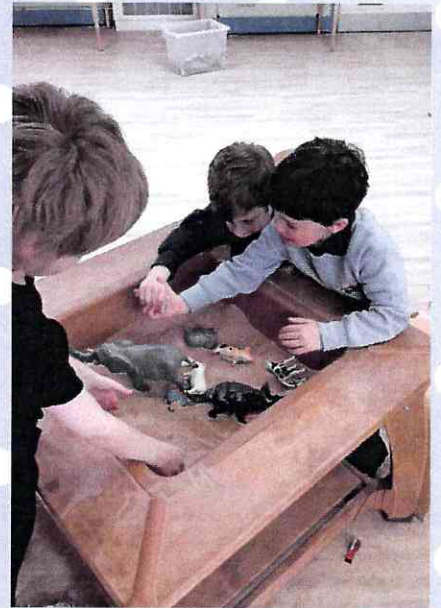
I look forward to working with you all this year.

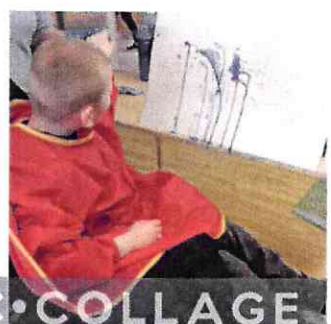

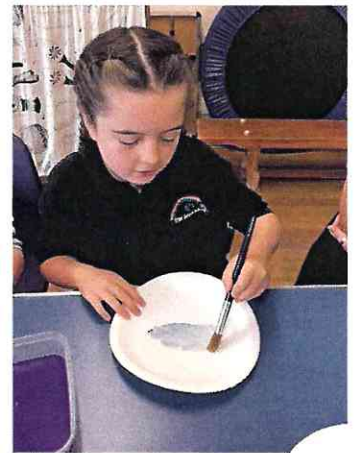


Maple and Willow class have been learning about the Water Cycle in a very sensory way.

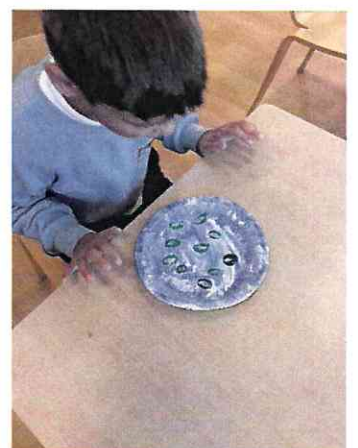
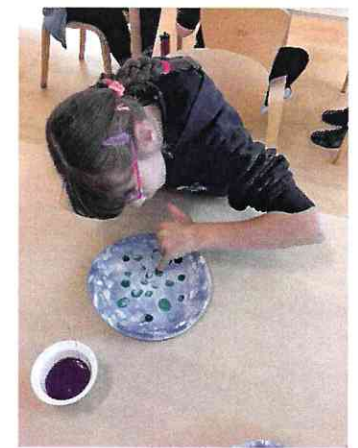
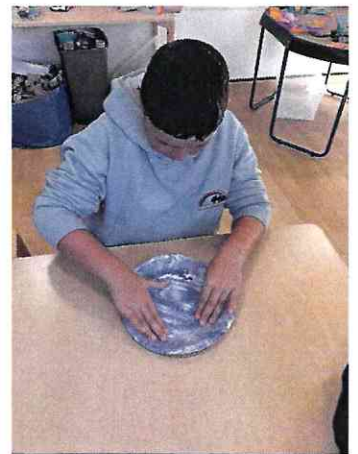
Beech Class

Sycamore Class Newsletter, September 2022

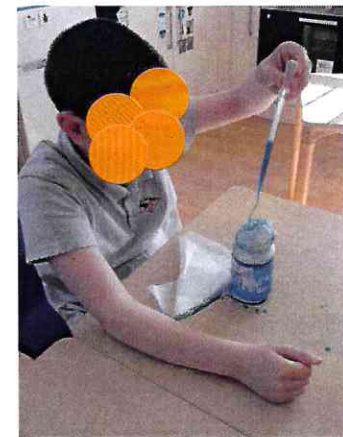

Art inspired by cloudy skies.

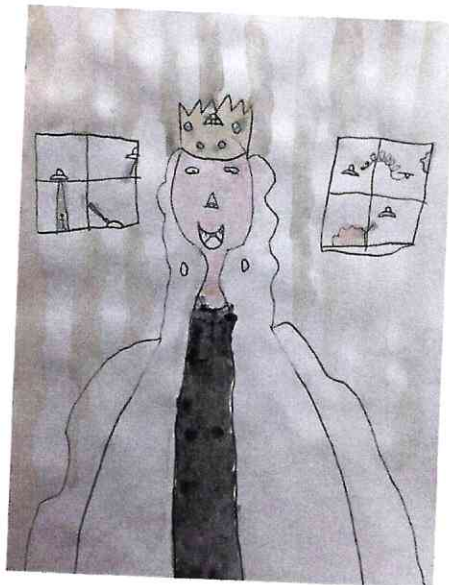
